And in like manner, wares and merchandise, which shall be exported from the States of the Northgerman Confederacy in any yessel whatsoever. or which shall be imported in vessels of the Northgerman Confederacy from any country whatsoever shall not be probibited by the Republic of Liberia. nor encumbered by higher duties than those wares or merchandise of the same kind arriving from any other foreign country or in any vessel whatsoever; and all produces of the Republic of Liberia shall be exported thence by subjects of the Northgerman Confederacy and vessels of the Northgerman Confederacy, on conditions as favorable as those, on which they may he exported by the subjects and ves-

## sels of any other foreign state.

ARTICLE 5. The protection of the Governments of the States of the German Confederacy shall be granted to all Liberian ships, their commanders and crews, If any such ship be wreeked upon the coast of the Northgerman Confederacy, the local authorities, shall afford them aid and protection against pillage, and care that all objects saved from the wreck shall be returned to their lawful owners. In like manner, the protection of the Government of the Republic shall be granted to all German ships, their commanders and crews, and if any such ship be wrecked on the coasts of the Republic of Liberia. the local authorities shall afford them aid and protection against pillage, and care that all objects saved from the wreck be returned to the lawful owners.
